

### Penninsular Cup

This event is for teams of 6 players. When teams from different divisions are paired together the following applies:-

Difference of 1 division 1½ points Difference of 2 divisions 2½ points Difference of 3 divisions 3½ points

In the event of a drawn match the bottom board is eliminated. If the match score is still level the 5th board is eliminated and so on until a victor is found.

A player is Cup tied to whichever team he/she plays for first.

All clubs entered into the WDCL by default have their A-Team entered into the Penninsular Cup. Other teams may also be entered at the league AGM. If a club requires their A-Team not to be entered into the Peninsular Cup this must be requested at the league AGM.

NB In the Final and Semi Final NO PLAYER IS ELIGIBLE TO PLAY WHO HAS NOT ALREADY PLAYED FOR THE CLUB IN THE SAME SEASON

### Kalmar Cup

This event is for teams of 5 players whose combined grade does not exceed 800.

Defaulted Boards count as 160 grading points.

Players must have either an ECF grade or a provisional grade from the WDCL to play in this competition.

In the event of a drawn match the team with the lowest grading wins.

A player is Cup tied to whichever team he/she plays for first.

NB In the Final and Semi Final NO PLAYER IS ELIGIBLE TO PLAY WHO HAS NOT ALREADY PLAYED FOR THE CLUB IN THE SAME SEASON.

It's up to the captains to check and confirm with the published WDCL grades that both teams are accurately represented when the teams are declared. If there is an error in a team declaration and the opposing captain does not check the grades and find it before the match, then the declared team is legal for that 1 match.

### Kalmar Shield

This event is for teams of 5 players whose combined grade does not exceed 600. Defaulted Boards count as 110 grading points. Players must have either an ECF grade or a provisional grade from the WDCL to play in this competition.

Players graded over 140 are barred from this competition.

In the event of a drawn match the team with the lowest grading wins.

A player is Cup tied to whichever team he/she plays for first.

NB In the Final and Semi Final NO PLAYER IS ELIGIBLE TO PLAY WHO HAS NOT ALREADY PLAYED FOR THE CLUB IN THE SAME SEASON.

It's up to the captains to check and confirm with the published WDCL grades that both teams are accurately represented when the teams are declared. If there is an error in a team declaration and the opposing captain does not check the grades and find it before the match, then the declared team is legal for that 1 match.

### Conflict Resolution

In the event of a draw in the Kalmar Shield or Cup between two teams that have exactly the same grade points, the winning team is decided by counting the board numbers of the wins i.e. if you win on board 1 you get 1 point, 2 pts for board 2 etc. The team with the lowest combined points total as described wins, if those scores are the same do the same calculation but with defaulted losses counting as +1, if they are still equal after that then the team with black on board 1 wins.

In the event of a drawn match in the Penninsular Cup the bottom board is eliminated. If the match score is still level the 5th board is eliminated and so on until a victor is found. If no victor is found, perform the same process, but with defaulted losses counting as -1, if they are still equal after that then the team with black on board 1 wins.
